number of large and small historical societies. This gave her a broad practical experience base by the time she moved to Fairfield Glade in 2006. She started the Kinseekers at Fairfield Glade shortly after moving here.

When the **Cumberland County Archives and Family Heritage Center** opened in 2010, she and several of the Kinseekers volunteered there. Within a few months, they asked Joyce to manage the Archives. She has completed the State Library and Archives course on Archives Management and continues to advocate for preservation of historical records in Cumberland County.
